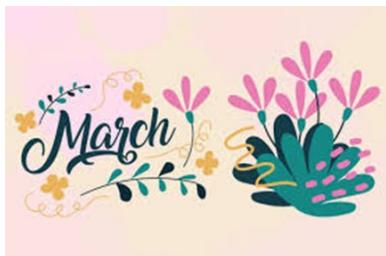


FABERGE EGGS

A **Faberge egg** is a jewelled egg first created by the House of Fabergé, in Saint Petersburg, Russia. As many as 69 eggs were created during the Czarist era, 1885-1917, of which 61 are known to have survived. Virtually all of the original first-edition eggs were manufactured under the supervision of Peter Carl Fabergé. The most famous of the firm's creations are the 50 Imperial Easter eggs, of which 44 are known to be in complete or partial physical existence, leaving the fate of those remaining unknown. The celebrated series of Easter eggs was created for the Russian Imperial family. These creations are inextricably linked to the glory and tragic fate of the last Romanov family. In the era of the Russian tsars, Fabergé's jewel-studded objects d'art were a royal riff on a much humbler Easter tradition. This documentary examines 12 of the most opulent and expensive eggs.

B-52 Stratofortress 65 Minutes

The B-52 Stratofortress long-range, high alert, subsonic, jet-powered strategic bomber was designed and built by Boeing and operated by the United States Air Force since the 1950s. The bomber can carry up to 70,000 pounds of weapons for more than 8,800 miles without aerial refueling.

The Silk Road: The Ancient Super-highway That Connected the World 54 Minutes

For over 2,000 years, the Silk Road was one of the most transformative networks in human history—stretching across Eurasia, linking China to the Mediterranean, and connecting empires, religions, and revolutions. Far more than a trade route, it became a corridor of power and conflict. The Silk Road didn't just carry goods—it carried weapons, warriors, and the seeds of military transformation.

Murano: between Water and Fire 31 Minutes

This is a documentary produced by Consorzio Promovetro to share the knowledge about Murano Island and the glassmaking history and industry. Kelp: Hidden Treasure of the Salish Sea | Changing Seas 27 Minutes

The kelp forests of the Puget Sound have long played an essential role in the local ecosystem as a habitat and food source. Today, this foundational species is in decline, but many advocates are working together to solve the mysteries of conserving and restoring kelp forests.

Hidden World: Elusive Creatures Living in Kelp Forests 25 Minutes

The Pacific coast hides a massive underworld that rivals any jungle on land. This documentary journeys through the towering kelp forests of the Channel Islands and the murky Emerald Sea of British Columbia. These vertical structures reach over three stories high, creating a complex habitat for some of the most specialized predators

in the ocean. You will see the massive Elephant Seal, a 5000-pound giant that can hold its breath longer than any other mammal. Deep in the rocks, 6-foot moray eels and strange wolf eels wait for their next meal. From the fast-growing giant kelp that shoots up 14 inches in one day to the rare black sea bass making a return from the brink of extinction, this is a look at a fragile yet powerful ecosystem.

Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina

Italian Composer

Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina is considered the leading composer of late 16th-century Europe. He composed more than 105 masses and 250 motets, a master of contrapuntal composition. Pope Marcellus Massis is the best known of his more than 100 masses. The work is renowned for its intricate interplay of vocal lines and has been studied for centuries as a prime example of Renaissance polyphonic choral music. His style is typified by a graceful melodic smoothness and careful treatment of dissonance, with the primary consideration being melody, and harmony coming as a secondary product of the melodic combination.
